

Jackie's inspiration:

One of my favourite computer games is Bejewelled and I wanted to create a motif that radiated opulence, warmth and glamour. Being wrapped in these colours would make me feel beautiful and shine like a jewel. I felt I needed (one round) of white (we put in cream) to represent diamonds.

Jane says:

We all know how popular the colour purple is – the shade Violet features in three of our shortlisted designs – and so it was a definite that we would choose a palette that featured purple and pink shades. What I love about Jackie's design is the way she has mixed her palette with the teal and cream to create a great colour effect.

Blanket Measurement Pre-blocked Measurement: approximately 102cm (40¼in) x 157cm (62in)

Blocked Measurement:

Approximately 127cm (50in) square

Equipment

4mm (US G6) and
4.5mm (US 7) crochet
hooks – please see
tension notes for the
Original Delft pattern
Stitch markers
Knitters sewing needle



Materials

Stylecraft Special DK $\,100\%$ Premium Acrylic, 295m (322yds), per 100gball

Total	16 balls
G Cream (1005)	2 balls
F Clematis (1390)	1 ball
E Violet (1277)	2 balls
D Magenta (1084)	2 balls
C Spearmint (1842)	2 balls
B Empire (1829)	3 balls
A Boysenberry (1828)	4 balls

Instructions

Work as the Original Delft Crochet Blanket replacing the yarns with the shades listed on page 4 of this download.

Note: At the end of Round 5 you will need to fasten off your yarn and join your next colour for Round 6. The easiest way to do this is to change yarn shade as you work the slip-stitch at the end of Round 5.

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Half Motif (make 4)


Work the yarn shades as for Motif Two, which replaces 'Medium' .




Edging

- **ROUND 5:** Violet **(E)**.
