Debby's inspiration:



Blanket Measurement Pre-blocked Measurement: approximately 102cm (40¼in) x 157cm (62in)

Blocked Measurement: Approximately 127cm (50in) square

Equipment

4mm (US G6) and 4.5mm (US 7) crochet hooks – please see tension notes for the Original Delft pattern Stitch markers Knitters sewing needle



Materials

Stylecraft Special DK 100% Premium Acrylic, 295m (322yds), per 100g ball

A Violet (1277)	4 balls
B Pistachio (1822)	2 balls
C Bottle (1009)	2 balls
D Saffron (1081)	2 balls
E Citron (1263)	2 balls
F Blush (1833)	2 balls
G Claret (1123)	2 balls
H Pomegranate (1083)	2 balls
Total	18 balls

Instructions

Work as the Original Delft Crochet Blanket replacing the yarns with the shades listed on page 4 of this download.


Note: At the end of Round 5 you will need to fasten off your yarn and join your next colour for Round 6. The easiest way to do this is to change yarn shade as you work the slip-stitch at the end of Round 5.

At the end of Round/Row 17 you do not fasten off as the same shade is used for Round/Row 18. Work 1ch at the beginning of Round/Row 18 and work from Line 4, omitting the instructions on how to join yarn.

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
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Half Motif (make 4)


Work the yarn shades as for Motif Two, which replaces 'Medium' .
