





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### Blanket Measurement

#### Pre-blocked Measurement:

approximately 102cm  
(40¼in) x 157cm (62in)

#### Blocked Measurement:

Approximately 127cm  
(50in) square

### Equipment

4mm (US G6) and  
4.5mm (US 7) crochet  
hooks – please see  
tension notes for the  
Original Delft pattern  
Stitch markers  
Knitters sewing needle



### Materials

Stylecraft Special DK 100% Premium Acrylic, 295m (322yds),  
per 100g ball

	<b>A</b> Buttermilk (1835)	4 balls
	<b>B</b> Blush (1833)	2 balls
	<b>C</b> Gold (1709)	2 balls
	<b>D</b> Cypress (1824)	1 ball
	<b>E</b> Lime (1712)	2 balls
	<b>F</b> Mustard (1823)	1 balls
	<b>G</b> Raspberry (1023)	2 balls
	<b>H</b> Grape (1067)	2 balls
	<b>Total</b>	<b>16 balls</b>

### Instructions


Work as the Original Delft Crochet Blanket replacing the yarns with the shades listed on page 4 of this download.

**Note:** At the end of Round 5 on the full motif and Row 5 on the half motif you will need to fasten off your yarn and join your next colour for Round/Row 6.

At the end of Round/Row 17 you do not fasten off as the same shade is used for Round/Row 18. Work 1ch at the beginning of Round/Row 18 and work from Line 4, omitting the instructions on how to join yarn.



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## Half Motif (make 4)


Work the yarn shades as for Motif Two, which replaces 'Medium'.

-  **ROUND 1:** Lime (E).
-  **ROUND 2:** Grape (H).
-  **ROUND 3:** Raspberry (G).
-  **ROUND 4:** Blush (F).
-  **ROUND 5:** Blush (F).
