

# **Indian Roses**

**Yarn Substitution Document For Naturals Version** 

















My Indian Roses blanket design was inspired by a trip to Mysore, India where I came across some lovely vintage ceramic tiles that featured pretty roses at the centre. The original design was worked using yarns from the West Yorkshire Spinners range, some of which are now discontinued, but you can use any DK weight yarn so long at it crochets to the same tension and is equal in length.

The yarns from West Yorkshire Spinners are fabulous and as they now have lots of shades in their gorgeous ColourLab DK range I have worked a couple of new sample motifs of the design as alternatives to the original. To work through this Naturals version, you will need the original pattern, which you can purchase either as a paper or a download copy, plus this yarn substitution document. You will need to refer to the original pattern for measurements, equipment needed and the pattern notes.

**West Yorkshire Spinners ColourLab DK** 100% British Wool

225m (245yds) per 100g ball

Please note that yarn amounts are approximate and are based on this order of substituting yarn and on using the correct tension.

\* We think yarn usage on this yarn shade may be tight if you make the full-size blanket so you might want to add in an extra ball.

## Main Motif (make 13)

- Using **Skelberry** and **4mm hook** throughout make 4ch, join with a ss to form a ring.
- Round 1: Using Skelberry.
- Round 2: Using Maywick.
- Round 3: Using Sand.
- Round 4: Using Dandelion.
- Round 5: Using Natural Cream.
- Round 6 & 7: Using Skelberry.
- Round 8: Using Maywick.
- Round 9: Using Skelberry.
- Round 10 & 11: Using Greenbank.
- Round 12: Using Pear Green.
- Round 13 & 14: Using Stormy Grey.
- Round 15: Using Silver Grey.
- Round 16: Using Natural Cream.
- Round 17: Using Pixie.
- Round 18: Using Sand.
- Row 19, 20 & 21: Using Hazel Brown.
- Round 22, 23 & 24: Using Silver Grey.

## Half Motif (make 8)

- Using **Skelberry** and **4mm hook** throughout make 4ch, join with a ss to form a ring.
- Row 1: Using Skelberry.
- Row 2: Using Maywick.
- Row 3: Using Sand.
- Row 4: Using Dandelion.
- Row 5: Using Natural Cream.
- Row 6 & 7: Using Skelberry.
- Row 8: Using Maywick.
- Row 9: Using Skelberry.
- Row 10 & 11: Using Greenbank.
- Row 12: Using Pear Green.
- Row 13 & 14: Using Stormy Grey.
- Row 15: Using Silver Grey.
- Row 16: Using Natural Cream.
- Row 17: Using Pixie.
- Row 18: Using Sand.
- Row 19, 20 & 21: Using Hazel Brown.
- Row 22, 23 & 24: Using Silver Grey.

## Quarter Motif (make 4)

- Using **Skelberry** and **4mm hook** throughout make 4ch, join with a ss to form a ring.
- Row 1: Using Skelberry.
- Row 2: Using Maywick.

- Row 3: Using Sand.
- Row 4: Using Dandelion.
- Row 5: Using Natural Cream.
- Row 6 & 7: Using Skelberry.
- Row 8: Using Maywick.
- Row 9: Using Skelberry.
- Row 10 & 11: Using Greenbank.
- Row 12: Using Pear Green.
- Row 13 & 14: Using Stormy Grey.
- Row 15: Using Silver Grey.
- Row 16: Using Natural Cream.
- Row 17: Using Pixie.
- Row 18: Using Sand.
- Row 19, 20 & 21: Using Hazel Brown.
- Row 22, 23 & 24: Using Silver Grey.

## **Making Up**

Using **Silver Grey** and **4mm hook**.

#### **Edging**

- Round 1 & 2: Using Natural Cream.
- Round 3: Using Silver Grey.
- Round 4: Using Hazel Brown.

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
