➤ Indian Roses Blanket - Naturals Version



My Indian Roses blanket design was inspired by a trip to Mysore, India where I came across some lovely vintage ceramic tiles that featured pretty roses at the centre. The original design was worked using yarns from the West Yorkshire Spinners range, some of which are now discontinued, but you can use any DK weight yarn so long as it crochets to the same tension and is equal in length.

The yarns from West Yorkshire Spinners are fabulous and as they now have lots of shades in their gorgeous ColourLab DK range I have worked a couple of new sample motifs of the design as alternatives to the original. To work through this Naturals version, you will need the original pattern, which you can purchase either as a paper or a download copy, plus this yarn substitution document. You will need to refer to the original pattern for measurements, equipment needed and the pattern notes.

MATERIALS

West Yorkshire Spinners ColourLab DK

100% British Wool
225m (245yds) per 100g ball

	Silver Grey (137)	5 balls
	Hazel Brown (491)	4 balls
	Natural Cream (010)	2 balls
	Stormy Grey (373)	2 balls*
	Pear Green (186)	1 ball




West Yorkshire Spinners Bo Peep DK

52% Falkland Wool 48% Nylon
112m (122yds) per 50g ball

	Pixie (326)	1 ball
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West Yorkshire Spinners Craft DK

Maywick
100% Shetland Islands Wool
225m (246yds) per 100g skein

	Greenbank (404)	1 skein
	Skelberry (850)	1 skein
	Maywick (512)	1 skein

West Yorkshire Bo Peep Pure Sand (208)

100% 52% Falkland Islands Wool
112m (122yds) per 50g skein

	Dandelion (446)	1 skein
	Sand (208)	1 skein

Please note that yarn amounts are approximate and are based on this order of substituting yarn and on using the correct tension.

* We think yarn usage on this yarn shade may be tight if you make the full-size blanket so you might want to add in an extra ball.

- Using **Skelberry** and **4mm hook** throughout make 4ch, join with a ss to form a ring.
- Round 1:** Using **Skelberry**.
- Round 2:** Using **Maywick**.
- Round 3:** Using **Sand**.

- Round 5:** Using **Natural Cream**.
- Round 6 & 7:** Using **Skelberry**.
